

Ordinance No. 31

Relating to Nuisances

The People of the Town of Lebanon
Linn County Oregon do Ordain as
follows

- Sec 1 That no person or persons shall cast or leave in any street or alley within the corporate limits of the Town of Lebanon any stable manure, bones putrid unsound unwholesome or refuse meat or any dead animal or fish or any unsound putrid or unwholesome substance or the offal garbage or the offensive part of any animal or animals under penalty of Ten Dollars.
- Sec 2 That the Owners or occupants of any house store building or premises in the Town of Lebanon to which a Privy Hog Pen Hog Trough swill Barrel Sewer or Sink belongs or appertains and who use and keep the same in such a condition as to cause a noisome or offensive smell it thereby becoming a public nuisance and who does not abate or remove said nuisance within three days after being so ordered by the Town Marshal shall be fined by the Recorder on conviction thereof not less than Ten or more than Fifty Dollars immediately after which conviction the Marshal shall proceed to remove or abate said nuisance at the expense of said person or persons so offending to be

recovered in an action before the Recorder in the name of the Town but in all cases the expenses of such removal shall be paid by the Town in case of failure to collect from the person or persons so offending.

Sec 3 On the nonpayment of any fine or costs imposed by the Recorder upon any person or persons convicted for any violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance by the person or persons so convicted the Recorder may imprison the person or persons so convicted and neglecting or refusing to pay the fine and costs imposed by the Recorder for any period not exceeding Twenty days

Sec 4 This Ordinance to be in full force and effect from and after five days after Publishing by posting
