

Ordinance Bill No. 32. Relating to the granting of License for the sale of Spiritous Malt or Vinous Liquors.

And the repeal of Ordinance No 30 passed by the Town Council Jan¹⁸⁸⁸ 4th -

The people of the Town of Lebanon Linn County Oregon do Ordain as follows.

Sec 1 That all of Ordinance No 30 be and is hereby repealed.

Sec 2 That every person keeping a Bar Room or drinking Shop shall pay an annual License of Three Hundred Dollars per annum or a semiannual License of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars.

Sec 3 That no License for keeping a Bar Room or Drinking Shop shall be granted for a less period than six months.

Every person who keeps malt or Spiritous Liquors or Wines for sale in less quantities than one gallon either as his sole buisness or in connection with some other buisness shall be deemed a keeper of a Bar Room or Drinking Shop under this Ordinance

Sec 4 All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed

Sec 5 This Ordinance to be in full force and effect from and after five

days after publication by posting
