

Ordinance Bill No. 33.

Relating to entering the cars during the time of switching or other changes, after trains arrive, without the express permission of the party in charge of said train, also relating to the use of profane and indecent language and disorderly conduct in or around the railroad Depot.

The people of the Town of Lebanon Linn Co. Oregon do ordain as follows

Sect. 1

Any person who shall enter or stand upon the platform of any car or cars, after the train has come in and before a reasonable time for the departure of said train, without the permission of the Conductor or such other person in charge of said train, shall be fined on conviction before the Recorder, not less than five dollars and not to exceed ten dollars for each and every offence.

Sect. 2

Any person using profane indecent or insulting language in or around the Railroad depot, or otherwise conducting him or themselves in a riotous or disorderly way, shall be fined on conviction before the Recorder not less than five dollars and not to exceed the sum of ten dollars for each and every offence.

Sect. 3 It shall be the duty of the Town Marshal to see that the provisions of this Ordinance are strictly enforced.

Sect. 4 This Ordinance to be in full force and effect from and after five days publication by posting.
