

Ordinance Bill No. 34.

Relating to the Public Health.

The people of the town of Lebanon do ordain as follows.

Sect. One It shall be the duty of the head of the family, or any other member of the family of legal age of said family, or the keeper of any boarding house or hotel, when any of said family or guests of said Boarding house or hotel is taken down or becomes exposed to any contagious disease such as Small pox, yellow fever, scarlet fever or diphtheria, to immediately report such case or the exposure of such person of such contagious disease to the President of the Town Council.

also it shall be the duty of each and every practicing physician within the corporate limits of said town to report immediately to the president of the town Council any of cases of the above mentioned contagious diseases in or under his medical treatment within said town. Upon such report made to the President of the Council it shall be his duty to call a immediately a special session of the town Council for the purpose of

guarding against the spread of such disease and the proper care and regulations to prevent of the same.

Any rules or regulations adopted either for the removal of said patient without the city to a safe as well as a suitable place for the treatment of said patient or such necessary and precautionary signals in case such patient is not removed as will give due notice to the public of the existence at such a place of a case of contagious disease as provided for in this ordinance. Said rules regulations and orders shall be carried into effect by the Town Marshal and he shall report the same with his action thereon with any expense incurred therein to the Town Council at any regular meeting of the Council or a special meeting called for that purpose.

Sect. 2.

It shall be unlawful for any person sick with any of the contagious diseases afore mentioned or any person knowing him or themselves to be exposed to the same to come ~~in~~ be brought by any person within the limits of the Town of Lebanon or any person or persons to bring the body of a deceased person knowing or having reasons for believing that said person came to his death by any of the aforesaid contagious diseases without first notifying the President of the Council and obtaining

through him a written permission in what way and manner to proceed in reference to the provisions of this section.

Dict. 3 Any person wilfully or negligently violating the provisions of this Ordinance or aid or assist in violating the plain meaning and intention of the same shall be fined on conviction before the Recorder in a sum not less than five dollars and not to exceed ten dollars.

Dict. 4 It shall be the duty of the Marshall to keep a close watch in regard to any of the contagious diseases herein named and report the same to the President of the Council, also to see that the provisions of this Ordinance are faithfully carried out.

Dict. 5 This Ordinance to be in full force and effect from and after five days publication by posting.
