

Ord

An ordinance to create the office of City Attorney; to define his duties; and regulate the salaries and fees of City offices.

The People of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows.

Sec 1. It shall be the duty of the City Council of said City to appoint a suitable person to serve as City Attorney, who shall hold his office during the pleasure of the Council and shall receive for his services the following compensation. The City Attorney shall receive a quarterly salary of fifteen (15) dollars, and for each conviction secured before the city Recorder the sum of two and one half (2.50) dollars additional and be reimbursed for all expenses necessarily incurred in attending to his duties as City Attorney. His duties shall be to attend all regular meetings of the city council; to give advice to any city officer in matters pertaining to their official duties; to write all complaints and prosecute all suits or actions wherein the city of Lebanon is plaintiff; and to defend all actions in suits wherein the city of Lebanon is defendant.

Sec 2. The Recorder of the city of Lebanon shall receive for his services the following compensation:

For issuing a warrant or writ	\$.50

" making exhibits of the receipts and disbursements of the City, per folio	.15
" making each order on the City Treasurer	.15
" " " receipt	.15
" issuing any license (to be paid by the person obtaining it)	1.00
" filing any paper required to be filed	.10
" Cancelling any order returned by the Treasurer	.10
" copying any ordinance per folio	.15
" assessing, each day employed	3.00
" making each notice and posting same.	.25
" each certificate of election	.25
" making, ruling and heading poll books each sheet	.50
" attending each council meeting	.50

Sec 3. The City Marshall shall receive the following compensation for his services:

For each days attendance upon the Recorder's court	\$1.00
" " juror sworn in the " "	.25
" " writ or warrant served by him	.50
" " subpoena served by him	.25
" " notice or summons served by him	.25
" " arrest made by him	1.00

Sec 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Sec 5 This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
