

Ordinance No 18

An Ordinance to amend Section 3 of Ordinance No 7, entitled an ordinance relating to the material to be used in and the manner of building and constructing sidewalks and crosswalks in the City of Lebanon.

The People of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Sec 1 That Section 3^d of Ordinance No 7, entitled an Ordinance relating to the material to be used in and the manner of building and constructing sidewalks and Crosswalks in the City of Lebanon be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows to-wit- Section 3^d.

All crosswalks within the City shall be constructed of Red or Yellow Fir lumber 8 inches by 3 inches or 10 inches by 3 inches, evenly sawed and to be nailed on bearings or sleepers of Red or Yellow Fir lumber, not less than 14) four inches by six (6) inches and oval shaped, and there shall be at least four of such bearings or sleepers under each section of crosswalk, said crosswalk shall be from (3½) three and one half feet to (4) four feet wide on the level, that is to say on top, as the Council may direct by order, duly made and entered on its journal. The edges to be level and a layer of gravel to be spread on each side of each crosswalk.

Sec 2 All parts of Ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Sec 3 This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its approval by the Mayor.
