

Ordinance No 20

An Ordinance to amend Section 9 of Ordinance 15, entitled "An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance No 4 and to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments and to provide for the manner of issuing licenses therefor."

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Sec 1 That Section 9 of Ordinance No 15, entitled an Ordinance to repeal Ordinance No 4 and to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments, and to provide for the manner of issuing license therefor, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Section 9- The owner or owners of any Hack, Cab, Hackney carriage, waggon, cart or other vehicle used for the transportation of passengers or any article of trade, earth, ballast, building material or other substance within the City limits, shall pay a yearly license of thirty (\$30) dollars for each vehicle drawn by one horse or other animal, and for each additional animal used in drawing such vehicle the additional sum of ten (\$10) dollars per year. Provided, that nothing contained in this Section shall be so construed as to require persons drawing dirt or gravel for the streets or highways, or drawing wood, gravel or other commodities from outside of the City limits, or persons engaged in the sale of Milk or dairy products within the City Limits to procure a license. The owner or driver of vehicles conveying passengers or merchandise as above mentioned, shall place the number of his vehicle as named in his license on his vehicle in a conspicuous place, in a neat and legible manner, in figures not less than one and one-half inches long and of proportionate width, and said number shall not be changed for any other number while such vehicle is subject to the payment of a municipal license, but said number may, at the option of the owner or owners of such

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vehicle, be transferred to and be placed upon any other vehicle, belonging to said owner or owners, provided that the vehicle to which the said number is transferred and placed shall not be drawn by a greater number of horses or other animals than the License allowed, and provided that the vehicle, to which the said number has been so transferred and placed, may be used in lieu of the vehicle, from which the said number was transferred and placed, without additional license; but no vehicle shall be used, for the purpose prohibited herein, without first having upon it the number required placed thereon in the manner herein specified.

Sec 2 All parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Sec 3 This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
