

Specified
 An Ordinance granting unto J L Cowan, Frank O'Neill and L Foley, their successors or assigns a right to erect and maintain a system of Electric lights and Electric power in the City of Lebanon, Linu Co, Oregon

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Sec 1 That there be and there is hereby given and granted unto J L Cowan, Frank O'Neill and L Foley their successors or assigns the right and franchise to erect and maintain in the streets and alleys of the City of Lebanon, Linu Co, Oregon, all such Electric lights, posts, poles, towers, wires and lines of wire and other fixtures as may be necessary or convenient or usually maintained for the purpose of carrying on a system of Electric lights and Electric power, in said City, and to construct, erect and put up in said City, all such buildings and machinery as may be necessary or convenient for such a purpose, Provided, that work on such a system of Electric lights and Electric power shall be commenced and reasonable progress made thereon within eight months from the approval of this Ordinance by the Mayor of said City, and shall have completed and put into operation said system of Electric lights within four months after work shall have been commenced thereon

This grant is made to said J L Cowan, Frank O'Neill and L Foley their successors or assigns for the period of fifteen years upon the express conditions that the said J L Cowan, Frank O'Neill and L Foley their assigns or successors shall at all times during said period of fifteen years after the erection of said system of Electric light furnish to the City of Lebanon free and without any charge whatever for the same, and as a consideration for this grant all the necessary light for the Council Chambers and the offices of the City authorities, and in case said grantee, their successors or assigns shall at any time

refuse or fail to furnish such Electric light for the use of the Council Chamber, office or place where the City authorities meet for the purpose of transacting City business, this grant shall be void and of no effect and the franchise herein and hereby granted shall immediately revert to the City of Lebanon

Sec 2 The said grantee of said right or franchise hereby granted, their successors or assigns shall erect such posts, poles, towers and stretch wires and lines of wire thereon in such a manner as not to interfere with the free and unobstructive use of the Streets or alleys for travel and at such height as may be designated by the Mayor and City Council of said City; and in no case shall any main or feeder or Street light be less than thirty (30) feet above the level of the Streets

Sec 3 Whenever it shall become necessary in the erection of any such posts, poles or towers to interfere in any manner with any street or alley, said grantee their successors or assigns shall without delay put such Streets or alleys in as good condition as it was before broken, dug up or disturbed; and shall remove all surplus sand, earth or rubbish from such street or alley —

Sec 4 Immediately upon the giving of any fire alarm, the Electric current in the immediate vicinity of the fire shall be shut off and so kept until the fire is over and all danger passed. Provided, however, that the shutting off of the Electric current within the immediate vicinity of the fire does not affect the lights in other parts of the City

Sec 5 Said City of Lebanon reserves the right to change or modify this Ordinance so as to regulate the charges for the use of Electric light or Electric power within said City to be charged by said J. L. Cowan, Frank O'Neill and S. Foley their successors or assigns

Sec 6

Within sixty days after the approval of this Ordinance by the Mayor, the said J. L. Cowan, Frank O'Neill and L. Foley their assigns or successors shall file with the Recorder of the said City of Lebanon, their written acceptance thereof and of its provisions.

Sec 7

This Ordinance will be in force and effect from and after the approval by the Mayor and its written acceptance by the said J. L. Cowan, Frank O'Neill and L. Foley, as provided in Section six (6) of this Ordinance x
