

Ordinance Bill No. 40

An Ordinance to amend a part of section 4 of Ordinance No. 37, Relating to Licensing the Sale of Spirituous Liquors.

The people of the Town of Lebanon, Linin County, Oregon, do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1. That the words "Town of Lebanon" appearing in the fourth line of the justification of the Bond on page 139. of Ordinance Book, be stricken out and the words "County of Linin" inserted.
- Sec. 2. That this Ordinance be in full force and effect from and after five days publication by posting
