Dear Mr. Bailey:

The Department of Environmental Quality has completed its review of your permit application and the comments received regarding the proposed permit provisions which were mailed to you for review on May 7, 1973, and has issued the attached Solid Waste Disposal Permit.

In response to your letter of May 17, 1973, the deadline for submitting the required final grading and closure plans has been extended to December 31, 1973, as you requested.

It is our understanding that you have become concerned that the Day Island Sanitary Landfill is filling more rapidly than anticipated and that the site may be full by July 1974. Inasmuch as there is presently no replacement site available, we support your proposal to slow the present rate of filling by diverting demolition and construction wastes and similar bulky, non-putrescible wastes to the Bethel-Danebo Demolition Landfill in Eugene.

You are urged to carefully read the attached permit and take all steps necessary to comply with the conditions contained therein.
