SUBJECT: Landfill Monitoring - Day Island

Day Island Landfill is not scheduled for routine monitoring well sampling this year (1988). However, we should try to observe and sample the reported leachate seep at low water. This should be coordinated with the regional office to help determine when the situation is right.

As for the new locked wells at Day Island, we assume they were installed by EPA in the course of their special study of the landfill a couple of years ago. It is possible the EPA wells would enhance our monitoring. This would have to be addressed before we do the next routine sampling (1990?).

As noted in Ernie Schmidt's March 29 memo to you, we agreed to not sample Whiteson, Santosh, Day Island and Newberg in 1988. We have not decided yet on Lebanon and Fowler's. Also, Kerby (3 wells) must be added to the list.
