Dear Mr. Orr,

Pursuant to the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) Voluntary Agreement for Remedial Investigation and Source Control Measures, LQVC-NWR-04-01, dated December 30, 2004 (Voluntary Agreement), and our discussions on these matters, we respectfully submit the following report. This letter report summarizes Remedial Investigation (RI) and Source Control (SC) activities at the Northwest Pipe Company (NW Pipe), Portland, OR facility during the period of October through December 2018.

Actions Taken Under the Voluntary Agreement during this Quarter

- October 2th NWP consultant Ken Shump and DEQ representative Henning Larson spoke regarding the Groundwater Work Plan via telephone.
- November 7th NW Pipe and DEQ met to discuss the preliminary monitored natural attenuation (MNA) framework. NW Pipe provided a discussion draft of the MNA Work Plan proposed framework compared to the 2004 EPA MNA guidance.
- December 4th through 7th NW Pipe conducted groundwater sampling in the Southeast Area using the same well network and analytes (except for ferrous iron substituted for ferric iron) as the Final Supplemental Groundwater Sampling and Data Evaluation (CH2M, 2016).

Actions Scheduled to be Taken in the Next Quarter

- o NW Pipe to proceed with instruction received regarding MNA work plan framework.
- NW Pipe to begin addressing comments on the final RI/SCE.
