Bidder must be prequalified in EART and ACP; other listed classes may be met by prequalified first-tier subcontractors as appropriate to the Scope of Work.

This public works contract is subject to <u>ORS 279C.800–279C.870</u> (Oregon BOLI prevailing wage) and, if applicable, the Davis-Bacon Act.
