Thank you for your 1,4-Dioxane Reconnaissance-Level Investigation, Summary Technical Memorandum for the East Multnomah County Cleanup Project, dated November 3, 2021. The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) approves this document with a request for an additional confirmation groundwater sampling event for wells BOP-44(ds) and CMW-17(ds). Both of these wells produced detections of 1, 4-dioxane, albeit at very low estimated concentrations, and below the DEQ Residential Tap Water Ingestion and Inhalation RBC of 0.46 μ g/L, used as the screening level for this project.

Please provide DEQ with a schedule for a 1, 4-dioxane confirmation groundwater sampling event for wells BOP-44(ds) and CMW-17(ds).
