URS Corporation (URS) respectfully submits this request on behalf of Chevron Pipe Line Company (CPL) to remove CPL's name under any listing associated with Aircraft Service International Group (ASIG), Environmental Cleanup Site Information (ECSI) ID 1832. You have confirmed in telephone conversations that CPL is not listed as a Responsible Party at this site, but rather an Interested Party. Their name mistakenly shows up as an Additional Party for the site, likely due to the proximity of the entities. This seems to have been an error that was made early on in the listing, and has been carried on unintentionally, and without any activity or liability directed towards CPL. However, due to lease agreements with the Port of Portland, it is important at this time to have CPL's name, and all liability, removed from the site listing.
