On September 18, 2025, DEQ received a request from PCC Structurals, Inc. Large Parts Campus (PCC) for an extension of the deadline to submit source test results from source testing of Baghouse 8901. On June 5, 2025, DEQ sent PCC a letter requesting source testing of Baghouse 8901, with source test results due within 60 days of the test completion. PCC completed the source testing on August 1, 2025, and reports they have not received the draft source test report from Mostardi Platt, the source test company.

DEQ may grant an extension based on the criteria set in [OAR 340-245-0030\(3\)](#), which require sources to demonstrate progress towards completing the submittal and show that a delay is necessary for good cause. DEQ understands that PCC has demonstrated progress on the source test report by completing the source testing ahead of schedule. Further, DEQ agrees that a delay may be necessary in order for PCC to receive and review the source test report from Mostardi Platt prior to submitting to DEQ.

For these reasons, DEQ approves PCC's request and grants a 17-day extension from the original submittal deadline of September 30, 2025. PCC's source test report must be submitted by no later than October 17, 2025.
