Oil Re-Refining Company, Inc. (ORRCo) was called in to the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) program on April 26, 2024. ORRCo submitted a CAO Emissions Inventory (Inventory) on December 20, 2024. In accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 340-245-0030(2), DEQ issued a written request on July 16, 2025, requiring additional information and a revised Inventory to be submitted by September 15, 2025. On August 25, 2025, DEQ received a request from ORRCo for an extension of the deadline to submit the Inventory and supporting information by no later than December 31, 2025.

DEQ may grant an extension based on the criteria set in OAR 340-245-0030(3), which require sources to demonstrate progress towards completing the submittal and show that a delay is necessary for good cause. DEQ finds that ORRCo has demonstrated progress on the Emissions Inventory by providing requested modeling files to address comment numbers 1 through 4, and 9 through 12 from DEQ's July 16, 2025, letter and providing the status of the remaining items from the letter. DEQ agrees that a delay may be necessary in order for ORRCo and their consultant to collect the additional requested information. For these reasons, DEQ approves ORRCo's request and grants an extension until December 31, 2025, from the original submittal deadline of September 15, 2025.

DEQ remains available to discuss this information request and answer any questions you may have. Failure to provide additional information, corrections, or updates to DEQ by the deadlines in this letter may result in a violation of OAR 340-245-0030(2).
