

RESOLUTION NO. 2672

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH METRO FOR THE PROVISION OF INTERTWINE SIGNAGE ALONG THE CH'AK CH'AK TRAIL

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:


1. The Ch'ak Ch'ak Trail in Troutdale is part of the Intertwine (aka 40-mile Loop) network that connects parks and trails throughout the Portland Metropolitan area.
2. The City of Troutdale operates and maintains the Ch'ak Ch'ak trail within the City's corporate limits.
3. Metro, the regional planning agency, serves as a coordinating body for the Intertwine trail network.
4. Metro has undertaken an effort to develop and provide consistent wayfinding signage for trails within the Intertwine network, including the Ch'ak Ch'ak trail.
5. Metro will provide design and installation of Intertwine wayfinding signage on the Ch'ak Ch'ak trail and the City of Troutdale will then own, operate, and maintain these signs.
6. Metro and the City of Troutdale desire to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement to formally establish their roles and responsibilities with regard to design, installation, ownership, operation, and maintenance of the subject trail signage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro for Intertwine wayfinding signage on the Ch'ak Ch'ak trail is approved.

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
