RESOLUTION NO. 2673

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE TRAIL NAME "CH'AK CH'AK" TO INCLUDE THE TRAIL THROUGH SHARON NESBIT HERITAGE PARK AND ALONG NE HARLOW ROAD

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Construction of the new park and trail along the west bank of the Sandy River is nearing completion.
- 2. The new park has been named the Sharon Nesbit Heritage Park. The trail through the park has not been formally named, nor has the future trail segment connecting the park to the existing Ch'ak Ch'ak trail.
- 3. Troutdale has a strong and proud tradition of honoring and remembering local history, including in the selection of names for public places and amenities.
- 4. The Parks Master Plan recommends improved wayfinding in Troutdale's trail systems.
- 5. The Parks Advisory Committee, after due consideration and hearing from the public and staff, recommended incorporating the new trail segment into the Ch'ak Ch'ak trail under the same name.
- 6. Extending the trail name "Ch'ak Ch'ak" to these additional trail segments will best serve the public interest and further preserve and honor the culture and history of local indigenous peoples.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The trail shown in Attachment A herewith shall henceforth be part of the Ch'ak Ch'ak trail and so named the "Ch'ak Ch'ak" trail.

Section 2. This Resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.
