

RESOLUTION NO. 2674

A RESOLUTION DEMONSTRATING A COMMITMENT TO SUPPORT A GRANT APPLICATION FOR A DEPARTMENT OF LAND CONSERVATION (DLCD) AND DEVELOPMENT TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANT TO FUND AN UPDATED ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES ANALYSIS (EOA).

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The city's last complete EOA was in 2011, and it has been notified by DLCD that there is funding available to support completing an EOA update.
2. The DLCD Technical Assistance Grant application requires an adopted resolution or letter of support from the governing body for the requested project funding.
3. There is no required monetary match requirement for Technical Assistance Grants, although it is encouraged and can be met via an in-kind contribution of staff time and other associated administration costs.
4. Upon completion of an updated EOA and upcoming housing studies as required by the state, the city will be well-positioned to start a Comprehensive Plan update.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE


Section 1. The Troutdale City Council demonstrates its support for the submittal of an application for a grant to the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development for a Technical Assistance Grant to update its Economic Opportunities Analysis as required by Statewide Land Use Goal 9, Economic Development.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
