Dear Mr. Miller:

Hexion Inc. operates a wastewater collection and treatment system under Water Pollution Control Facilities (WPCF) Permit No. 101334. DEQ conducted review of annual reports associated with the WPCF permit, in conjunction with a permit transfer request submitted on December 1, 2025. Based on this review, DEQ has documented forty (40) violations. These are described in the following warning letter.

Violations: Failure to Monitor

Schedule B.2, Table B.1 of the WPCF permit provides minimum monitoring frequencies for the wastewater storage basins.

The facility submits annual reports, due February 15th of each year following the reporting period. While the annual reports describe the month typically monitored as “Basin dry, frozen, or insufficient water for sampling”, quarterly monitoring is required for each parameter listed for the months specified. Quarters are defined as: Q1 = January – March, Q2 = April – June, Q3 = July – September, and Q4 = October – December. Quarterly monitoring should be conducted during any of the months within the quarter to satisfy the monitoring condition.

DEQ has concluded that Hexion Inc. is responsible for the following violations of the WPCF permit:


