▶ **Next Steps:**

**Enter into a cost recovery agreement with DEQ.** DEQ requires that persons requesting DEQ review and oversight of investigation and cleanup activities agree to the terms of the Cost Recovery Agreement and pay project oversight costs. Electing not to enter into this agreement does not release you from any responsibility that you might have for any reporting requirements, investigation and/or cleanup of petroleum (hazardous substances).

**Consider submitting an insurance claim.** An insurance claim may be an option to cover the costs of investigating and cleaning up contamination related to the UST release. Under 40 CFR §280.97, UST owners and operators are required to maintain and demonstrate financial responsibility to cover the costs associated with accidental releases. If your financial responsibility mechanism includes pollution liability insurance, we recommend reviewing your policy and contacting your provider to determine if coverage applies.

In enter into a cost recovery agreement with DEQ follow the steps below.

1. Register for a Responsible Official account. <https://www.oregon.gov/deq/permits/Pages/Account-Registration.aspx>
2. A Facility should already exists at your address, link your account to the related Facility. Detailed instructions are located in Section 2 of the User Guide.
3. Complete the **LUST/Leaking HOT Cost Recovery Agreement** submittal.
