Revised Architectural Monument Drawings

- Marks presented the revised drawings, which included suggestions given at the last meeting – seating, plant hangers, pole lanterns similar to those downtown, the City's incorporation date inscription, night lighting, and a strawberry sculpture.

Additional Suggestions

- Adding a light fixture to the pole on the east side of the street. Williams will check into requirements.
- Adding a strawberry emblem (instead of the strawberry sculpture) on the east base.
- Inscriptions on the back of the monument – similar to the front except the words "Welcome to."
- Removing the rear flower baskets.
- According to Williams, the fluted poles are not rated for hanging banners so he will look into different poles.
- Williams spoke about possible sidewalk changes.

Next Meeting: To speed the process, Marks will email these revisions to committee members for their feedback/approval. The hope is that ODOT consents in time to build the monument this summer.
