DEQ called in the ATI Specialty Alloys & Components, LLC (ATI) facility in Millersburg, OR to the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) program on September 5, 2025. On November 18, 2025, DEQ received a request from ATI for a partial extension of the deadline for submittal of the CAO Emissions Inventory (Inventory), which DEQ granted on November 21, 2025. To date, DEQ has received the following partial Inventory submittals:

- Inventory Part 1: Process flow diagrams; Categorically Exempt Toxics Emissions Units (TEUs) Form AQ523; and emissions information (AQ520 form) for the natural gas combustion and emergency engine TEUs initially submitted on December 4, 2025 (Your DEQ Online Submittal ID 72766), and revised February 19, 2026.
- Inventory Part 2: Emissions information (AQ520 form) for all cooling towers, pickling tanks, and abrasive blasting TEUs submitted on February 19, 2026. Emissions for these TEUs were combined in a single AQ520 with the TEUs from Inventory Part 1.

As specified in DEQ's letter dated January 30, 2026, DEQ met with ATI on February 24, 2026, to discuss the timeline for submitting the remaining Inventory information. Based on that discussion, and in accordance with [Oregon Administrative Rule \(OAR\) 340-245-0030\(1\)&\(3\)](#), ATI must:

1. Provide to DEQ a comprehensive list of all baghouses, tank scrubbers, and gasoline dispensing facilities at the facility by **April 8, 2026**. The list should designate the subset of baghouses, scrubbers, and/or gasoline dispensing facility TEUs which will be included in the Inventory Part 3.
2. Schedule a meeting with DEQ to discuss the proposed submittal plan for the Inventory Part 3 and Inventory Part 4, to take place **no later than April 10, 2026**.
3. Submit to DEQ an Inventory including all baghouses, scrubbers, and gasoline dispensing facilities TEUs identified by ATI per Item 1 of this letter by **April 17, 2026**. The Inventory should include the AQ520 form and all supplemental documentation required under [OAR-340-245-0040\(4\)](#). A separate AQ520 form including only these TEUs may be used instead of adding to the AQ520 form submitted on February 19, 2026.

DEQ requests that you submit additional information to complete your Inventory. If you think that any of that information is confidential, trade secret or otherwise exempt from disclosure, in whole or in part, you must comply with the requirements in [OAR 340-214-0130](#) to identify this information. This includes clearly marking each page of the writing with a request for exemption from disclosure and stating the specific statutory provision under which you claim exemption. Emissions data is not exempt from disclosure.

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DEQ remains available to discuss this information request with you and answer any questions you may have. Failure to provide additional information, corrections, or updates to DEQ by the deadlines above may result in a violation of [OAR 340-245-0030\(4\)\(b\)](#).
