RESOLUTION 26-R-1286

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR A USDA RURAL DEVELOPMENT GRANT FOR THE EASY STREET WATER LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings' Water Master Plan has identified the Easy Street Water Line Replacement as a high-priority project due to aging, undersized water infrastructure and fire flow deficiencies; and

WHEREAS, the City has been approved for \$1,000,000 in Community Project Funding to be administered through the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Rural Development program; and

WHEREAS, USDA Rural Development requires authorization from the City Council for the City Manager to submit a formal grant application on behalf of the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for a USDA Rural Development grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the Easy Street Water Line Replacement project and to execute all documents necessary for the submission of the application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

Passed by the City Council January 26, 2026 and made effective the same date.
