Microchip Technology Incorporated (Microchip) was called in to the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) program on June 30, 2025. Microchip submitted an Emissions Inventory (Inventory) on December 23, 2025. In accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule [\(OAR\) 340-245-0030\(2\)](#), DEQ issued a written request on March 27, 2026, requiring additional information and a revised Inventory to be submitted by May 26, 2026. On May 8, 2026, Microchip submitted a request to DEQ for a 30-day extension of the deadline for submittal of the Inventory (Your DEQ Online submittal 69889). DEQ discussed the extension request with Microchip on May 11, 2026.

Microchip is requesting this extension partly in order to refine the requested potential maximum emissions used in the Inventory, after drafting a revised Inventory based on DEQ's letter dated March 27, 2026. Microchip indicated that the supporting emission factor documentation and Inventory revisions requested by DEQ are substantially complete, but that additional time is requested to ensure the quality of the submittal and to confirm the appropriateness of the requested potential to emit values. Microchip is proposing to submit a full Inventory no later than June 25, 2026.

DEQ may grant an extension based on the criteria set in [OAR 340-245-0030\(3\)](#), which require sources to demonstrate progress towards completing the submittal and show that a delay is necessary for good cause. Microchip has made progress on the Inventory by completing initial Inventory revisions and gathering the supporting data requested. DEQ agrees that a delay is likely to result in higher quality submittal and potentially fewer revisions.

For these reasons, DEQ approves Microchip's request and grants a 30-day extension from the original submittal deadline of May 26, 2026. Microchip's Inventory must be submitted by no later than **June 25, 2026**.
