Proposal highlights

The property is currently occupied by Galvco. Galvco has completed several subsurface investigations and performed risk evaluation to demonstrate there are no unacceptable risks for current receptors. In addition, DEQ issued a source control evaluation and decision. Institutional controls are proposed for the Galvco site to protect future receptors from potential unacceptable risks.

Background

The property was historically used for galvanizing metal parts.
