RESOLUTION NO. 90-454

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE THREE-WAY STOP SIGNING OF HALL STREET AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH MERRYMAN STREET, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, having received and considered the petition of the residents of the Hall/Merryman neighborhood requesting a three-way stop at the intersection of Hall and Merryman,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Signing: S. E. Hall Street at its intersection with S.E. Merryman Street is hereby made a stop street and shall be signed as such in both a northerly and southerly direction, thereby creating a three-way stop with Merryman.

Section 2. Change Authorized: The City Manager is directed to cause standard traffic signs to be installed as necessary to carry out the foregoing provisions.

Section 3. Effective Date: This Resolution shall become effective upon approval and adoption.
