A RESOLUTION DECLARING SURPLUS MATERIALS TO BE SOLD AT PUBLIC AUCTION OR OTHERWISE DISPOSED OF, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City has surplus materials, supplies and property which are no longer needed for City operations, which items are more particularly described on "Exhibit A" attached hereto, item numbers 8500 through 8544 and 8546 through 8555 being abandoned property in the possession of the City, and item number 8545 being surplus City property; and

WHEREAS, an auction of surplus government property will be held at the Washington County Fairground on May 12, 1990.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Surplus: That items 8500 through 8555 as described on Exhibit "A" are declared surplus.

Section 2. Disposal: That the items numbered 8500 through 8520, 8522 through 8536, 8541 through 8548, 8550 through 8551, and 8554 are declared no longer necessary and useful for City operations and purposes and shall be immediately sold or disposed of.

Section 3. Auction: That it is hereby ordered that the items described in Section 2 be offered for sale at public auction to the highest bidder, said auction be held in accordance with applicable City ordinances.

Section 4. Other Means of Disposal: If not sold at auction, the items in Section 2 shall be disposed of or destroyed in accordance with applicable City ordinances.

Section 5. Effective Date: That this Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
