

**City of Sherwood, Oregon**  
**RESOLUTION NO. 90-459**

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE 9-1-1 EMERGENCY SYSTEM, AUTHORIZING MAKING THE REQUEST FOR THESE CHANGES THROUGH TUALATIN VALLEY FIRE AND RESCUE TO THE STATE OF OREGON, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Tualatin Valley Fire and Rescue (TVFR) has recommended a relocation of the 9-1-1 answering points; and

WHEREAS, the basic 9-1-1 Service will be relocated to Washington County Consolidated Communications Agency (WCCCA), and the Enhanced 9-1-1 services will be relocated to Clackamas County Communications; and

WHEREAS, for the central offices of Stafford, Wilsonville and Charbonneau, an upgrade of service to Enhanced 9-1-1 will occur; and

WHEREAS, the transfer of Basic 9-1-1 services for the central offices of Tualatin, Tigard and Sherwood will begin the first step of a consolidated communications effort;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1. Authorization: The City of Sherwood hereby supports the proposed modifications to the 9-1-1 system and authorizes the City to participate in the request for this change through Tualatin Valley Fire and Rescue to the State of Oregon.


Section 2. Agreement: The City's support of the transfer of 9-1-1 from TVFR to WCCCA is conditioned on the eventual execution of a services agreement, or similar document, between WCCCA and the City, such as the existing City agreement with TVFR, assuring an adequate level of 9-1-1 service to City residents.

Section 3. Effective Date: This Resolution shall become effective upon approval and adoption.
