A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FOUR-WAY STOP SIGNING OF WASHINGTON & SECOND STREET AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council having received and considered the testimony of Glen Ault requesting a four-way stop sign at Washington Street and Second Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1: Signing:</u> Washington Street at its intersection with Second Street is hereby made a stop street and shall be signed such in both Northerly and Southerly directions, thereby creating a four-way stop at its intersection with Second Street.

<u>Section 2. Change Authorized:</u> The City Manager is directed to cause standard traffic signs to be installed as necessary to carry out the foregoing provisions.

<u>Section 3. Effective Date:</u> This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
