WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer appropriations totaling \$14,500 from the Contingency category of the Street Fund with \$14,500 being transferred to the Materials and Services category, and

WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer appropriations totaling \$3,738 from the Contingency category of the Library Fund with \$2,290 being transferred to the Personal Services category, and \$1,448 being transferred to the Materials & Services category, and

WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer appropriations totaling \$5,700 from the Contingency category of the Park & Open Space SIF Fund with \$5,700 being transferred to the Materials and Services category, and

WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer appropriations totaling \$1,000 from the Contingency category of the Bancroft Redemption Fund with \$1,000 being transferred to the Materials & Services category, and

WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer appropriations totaling \$20 from the Transfer to Other Funds Category of the State Revenue Sharing Fund with \$20 being transferred to the Capital Outlay category, and

WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer appropriations totaling \$64,162 from the Contingency category of the Regional Sewer Reimbursement SRF Fund with \$64,162 being transferred to the Materials & Services category, and

WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer appropriations totaling \$9,182 from the Contingency category of the Regional Storm Water Improvement SIF Fund with \$9,182 being transferred to the Materials & Services category, and

WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer appropriations totaling \$1,480 from the Contingency category of the Building Rental Fund with \$1,480 being transferred to the Materials & Services category, and
