A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FOUR-WAY STOP SIGNING OF MAIN STREET, RAILROAD STREET AND SOUTH SHERWOOD BOULEVARD INTERSECTION AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council having received and considered the testimony of the City Engineer requesting a four-way stop sign at Main Street, Railroad Street and South Sherwood Boulevard.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Signing: Railroad Street at its intersection with Main Street and South Sherwood Boulevard is hereby made a stop street and shall be signed such in both direction, and South Sherwood Boulevard at Railroad Street will become a full stop (including right turns), and thereby creating a four-way stop at the intersection.

Section 2. Change Authorized: The City Manager is directed to cause standard traffic signs to be installed as necessary to carry out the foregoing provisions.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
