Resolution No. 94-587

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A WATER MANAGEMENT GOAL FOR THE TUALATIN RIVER BASIN AND DECLARING INTENT TO PARTICIPATE IN GOAL IMPLEMENTATION, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 8, 1993, the Unified Sewerage Agency of Washington County, Oregon, (the "Agency") commenced a feasibility study to evaluate organizational options for consolidating water management functions; and

WHEREAS, The Agency received Technical Memorandums for the study dated September 15, 1993, December 16, 1993, and February 3, 1994, which contain the results of its continuing progress; and

WHEREAS, The agency received a Decision Document, dated April 1994, which recommends, in part, that all appropriate entities in the Tualatin River basin adopt the recommended goal (the "Goal");


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Goal: The City hereby adopts the goal of "Consolidate water management functions in the Tualatin River Basin."

Section 2. Intent: The City declares its intent to implement the GOAL and hereby directs the Sherwood City Manager to work with and encourage all entities to move forward toward the Goal.

Section 3. Effective Date: This Resolution shall become effective upon approval and adoption.
