A RESOLUTION INITIATING ACTION TO TRANSFER JURISDICTION OF CERTAIN COUNTY ROADS WITHIN THE CITY TO THE CITY.

WHEREAS, ORS 373.270(6) provides a mechanism to transfer jurisdiction of County Roads within a City to a City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood has determined it necessary, expedient and for the best interests of the city to acquire jurisdiction over certain county roads or part thereof to the same extent as it has over other public streets and alleys of the city.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Transfer Request: The Council hereby requests Section 1. that the Commissioners of Washington County, Oregon transfer jurisdiction of those County Roads, described and depicted in Exhibits "A" and "B" attached hereto, to the City of Sherwood; said request to be granted or denied within one year of the execution of this Resolution.

Section 2. Effective Date: This resolution shall become effective upon approval and adoption.

The City Recorder be and is hereby instructed to deliver a certified copy of the foregoing resolution to the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Oregon.

SEE EXHIBIT "B" ITEM "1"

A PORTION OF SUNSET BOULEVARD (COUNTY ROAD NO. 441) Lying between the Willamette and Pacific Railroad (formerly Southern Pacific) and the West line of Gregory Park, a record subdivision.

That portion of County Road No. 441 lying between the West right of way of the Willamette and Pacific Railroad and the East line of Section 31, T2S, R1W, W.M. Said road being situated in the Southeast one quarter of Section 31, T2S, R1W, W.M.

SEE EXHIBIT "B" ITEM "2" A PORTION OF SUNSET BOULEVARD (COUNTY ROAD NO. A-40, 311, 341, AND 441) Lying between Ladd Hill Road and Murdock Road.

That portion of County Road No. A-40 lying between the beginning of said County Road and that portion transferred by County Road No. 2448T/J. All of County Road No. 311 except that portion transferred by County Road No. 2448T/J. All of County Road No. 341. That portion of County Road No. 441 lying between the terminus of said County road and that portion transferred by County Road No. 2594T/J. Said road being situated in the Southwest and Southeast on quarters of Section 32, T2S, R1W, W.M.

SEE EXHIBIT "B" ITEM "3" A PORTION OF MURDOCK ROAD (COUNTY ROAD NO. 2257) Lying between Roy Street and Clackamas County.

That portion of County Road No. 2257 lying between the beginning point of said County Road and that portion transferred by County Road No. 2594T/J. Said road being situated in the Southeast one quarter of Section 32 and the Southwest one quarter of Section 33, T2S, R1W, W.M.

SEE EXHIBIT "B" ITEM "4" A PORTION OF COUNTY ROAD NO. 433 Lying North of Brookman Road.

That portion of County Road No. 433 lying between the beginning point and a point 20 feet northerly from angle point number one of said County Road. Said road being situated in the Southwest one quarter of Section 32, T2S, R1W, W.M.



FINDS AND DETERMINES that it is necessary, expedient and in the best interests of Washington County to surrender jurisdiction to the City of Sherwood, Oregon, the roads as hereinabove described, and it is hereby

RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the jurisdiction of the County over said roads as described and depicted in Exhibits "A" and "B" and responsibility for and the full and absolute jurisdiction over said road for all purposes shall vest in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, and the City shall have the same control, power and jurisdiction of the road or portions thereof as are by its Charter and the laws of the State of Oregon given or granted over any of the public streets and alleys of said City; and it is further

RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the County Surveyor of Washington County, Oregon, hereby is ordered to amend as necessary the official records of Washington County, Oregon, to indicate the surrender of jurisdiction as herein above described; and it is further RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the County Surveyor hereby is authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution and Order to the City of Sherwood, Oregon, as due notice of the surrender of jurisdiction.


