

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the city of Sherwood, Oregon, at a special meeting held at the City Hall on April 18, 1963, James Prendergrast submitted a preliminary plat of an area within the corporate boundaries of the city of Sherwood, for approval of the Council.

WHEREAS, certain existing streets and roadways which are bordering upon the proposed platted area are only 40 feet in width and;

WHEREAS, City ordinance pertaining to subdivisions specify that principal streets be 50 feet in width, and;

WHEREAS, City Attorney, Fred Anderson recommended that the City Council approve said plat provided the owner, James Prendergrast, dedicate to the City by deed for public use as a street or highway, a five foot strip adjacent and parallel to all existing streets or ways which border said proposed platted area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT HEREBY IS RESOLVED, as follows:

That upon compliance with the recommendation above set forth, this resolution shall become effective.
