

R E S O L U T I O N

1. BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby adopts the recommendation of the City Planning commission regarding a change of Zone on the within described real property , known as the Andresen property, situated within the boundaries of the incorporated limits of the City of Sherwood, Oregon.

2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the signatures of adjoining property owners attached to the accompanying petition be hereby acknowledged as evidence of consent to such change of Zone.

3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as soon as practicable, an ordinance be prepared and passed by the Council to amend that section of Ordinance No. 402 to conform to the recommendation of the City Planning Commission regarding the following described real property:

The South 700' of the following described tract:-
Beginning at a point 418 feet South of the Northwest corner of the West half of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 32, Township 2 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, thence East 209 feet; thence North 209 feet; thence East 451 feet; thence South 1111 feet; thence West 660 feet; thence North 902 feet; to the place of beginning, Washington County, Oregon; and commencing 209 feet South of the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 32, Township 2 South of Range 1 West of the W. M., Washington County, Oregon, thence South 209 feet; thence East 209 feet; thence North 209 feet; thence West 209 feet to the place of beginning.
