CITY OF SHERWOOD, OREGON

RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF SHERWOOD OF MARCH 8, 1967, WITH RESPECT TO WITHDRAWAL OF CERTAIN TERRITORY WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF SHERWOOD FROM THE TUALATIN RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, certain lands hereinafter described are included within the corporate limits of theCity of Sherwood by reason of annexation proceedings heretofore conducted by the City and likewise included in the boundaries of the Tualatin Rural Fire Protection District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 222,520 and 222.524, Oregon Revised Statutes, the Council of the City of Sherwood intends to withdraw said lands from the Tualatin Rural Fire Protection District:

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sherwood as follows:

(1) That the City of Sherwood, acting through its duly constituted City Council, does hereby record its intention to withdraw from the Tualatin Rural Fire Protection District the following described lands:

Beginning at a point on the section line 1313.0 feet south of the northeast corner of Section 31, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Washington County, Oregon; thence South along the east line of said section 894.7ufeet to a point; thence South 89° 08' West 1318.0 feet to a point; thence North 0° 39' West 1330.6 feet to a point; thence North 89° 12' East 100 feet to a point; thence North 0° 39' West 220 feet to a point; thence North 89° 12' East 395 feet to a point; thence South 0° 39' East 658.5 feet to a point; thence North 89° 11' East 825.0 feet to the point of beginning;

(2) That a public hearing be, and the same is hereby, called to be held on Friday, the 12 day of APRIL, 1967, at the hour of 8:00 p.m. at the City Hall in the City of Sherwood

at which time and place the City Council will hear objections, if any there be, to said proposal for the withdrawal of said area and shall determine if said withdrawal is for the best interests of the City;

(3) That the City Recorder of the City of Sherwood be, and she is hereby, directed to give notice of the time and place and purpose of said hearing by publication in the Tri-City Times once each week for two successive weeks for three publishings in all, prior to said hearing, and shall cause notice of said hearing to be posted at four public places in the City for a like period.
