RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF SHERWOOD OF ~~FEBRUARY~~ *April* 1968 WITH
RESPECT TO WITHDRAWAL OF CERTAIN TERRITORY WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES
OF THE CITY OF SHERWOOD FROM TUALATIN RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, certain lands hereinafter described are included within the corporate limits of the City of Sherwood by reason of annexation proceedings heretofore conducted by the City and likewise included in the boundaries of the Tualatin Rural Fire Protection District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 222.520 and 222.524, Oregon Revised Statutes, the Council of the City of Sherwood intends to withdraw said lands from the Tualatin Rural Fire Protection District,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sherwood as follows:

(1) That the City of Sherwood, acting through its duly constituted City Council, does hereby record its intention to withdraw from the Tualatin Rural Fire Protection District the following described lands: As set forth on the attached sheet headed "DESCRIPTION" and by this reference made a part hereof.

(2) That a public hearing be, and the same is hereby called to be held on Wednesday, the ~~14th~~ *15th* day of ~~February~~ *April*, 1968 at the hour of 8:00 p.m. at the City Hall, Sherwood, Oregon, at which time and place the City Council will hear objections, if any there be, to said proposal for the withdrawal of said area and shall determine if said withdrawal is for the best interests of the City.

(3) That the City Recorder of the City of Sherwood be, and she is hereby, directed to give notice of the time and place and purpose of said hearing by publication in the Tri-City Times once each week for two successive weeks for three publishings in all, prior to said hearing, and shall cause notice of said hearing to be posted at four public places in the City for a like period.

Beginning at the S.E. corner of the W1/2 of the NE1/4 of Sec.31, T2S, R1W, W.M., Washington County, Oregon, thence West 20.0 chains to the center of Sec. 31; thence along the southerly line of tract conveyed to Mary Elwert as described on page 466 of Book 402 Washington County, Oregon Deed Records S89°39'W 200 feet to a point; thence N29' E 12 chains to a point on the North line of said tract conveyed to Mary Elwert as described on page 466 Book 402 said Deed Records; thence S89°39'W 1780 feet, more or less, to the Southeasterly line of S. W. Pacific Highway right-of-way; thence Northeasterly along said right-of-way _____ feet, more or less, to the North line of tract conveyed to Edward Ehrenfelt and Anna Ehrenfelt, husband and wife, as described on page 417 Book 264, said Deed Records; thence East to the northeast corner of said Ehrenfelt tract; thence South along the West line of the NE1/4 of said Sec. 31 to the Northwest corner of the SW1/4 of the SW1/4 of said NE1/4; thence East 10.0 chains, more or less, to the Northeast corner thereof; thence North 5.0 chains to the N.W. corner of the S1/2 of the NE1/4 of the SW1/4 of NE1/4 of said Sec.31; thence East 10.0 chains to the N.E. corner thereof; thence South along the East line of said W1/2 of NE1/4 to the place of beginning.
