RESOLUTION CANVASSING RETURNS OF SPECIAL CITY ELECTION; PROCLAIMING RESULT AND DIRECTING RECORDER TO ENTER ELECTION RESULT IN THE RECORD

WHEREAS, there has been duly and regularly certified to the City by the election board, the following returns of the election held in the City of Sherwood on June 28, 1972, whereat there was submitted to the electors the question of authorization or rejection of a proposed special tax levy providing funds for the operation and maintenance of essential City functions, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 14 of the Charter of the City of Sherwood, the Council is required to canvass the said returns and proclaim the results and direct the Recorder to enter the results in the records of the Council proceedings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Sherwood as follows:


That the returns of election as certified to the City Recorder by the election board, be, and the same are hereby, canvassed and the results declared as follows:

Total ballots cast:	110
Approving:	51
Disapproving:	59

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED AND PROCLAIMED that the proposed tax levy as submitted to the voters has been disapproved by the voters.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Recorder be, and she is hereby, directed to enter a copy of this resolution in the record of the journal of the proceedings of this Council.
