RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A PARK COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF SHERWOOD.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED to establish a Park Commission for the City of Sherwood, Oregon, according to the Sherwood City Charter, adopted April 30, 1924. As stated in Chapter 28, Section 270, page 47 of said Charter, the Park Commission is to be composed of three residents of said City. The mayor is authorized, under this section, to appoint the three members as follows:

- (1) one member to serve for one year
- (2) one member to serve for two years
- (3) and one member to serve for three years,

and appointment thereafter shall be made for a term of three years, it being the intent to provide for one new appointment each year.

Pursuant to Ch 29, Section 271, page 47 of said Charter, the Park Commission shall, under the general direction of the City Council, have the oversight and management of City Park, in said City and any other parks, or additions, thereto, which the City may hereafter acquire, and shall, subject to the advice and consent of the City Council, improve said park and grounds, control and regulate the use thereof for celebrations and other gatherings of a public nature, collect all revenues from such park, or parks, and file with the City Council detailed accounts of the monies received and expended on account of said park improvements made thereon, and such other matters as the Council may at any time prescribe.

ADOPTED by the City Council, the 27 day of March, 1974.
