

CITY RESOLUTION FOR ANNEXATION
AND CONCURRENCE FOR TRIPLE MAJORITY

RESOLUTION NO. 134

A Resolution furthering annexation to the City of Sherwood of the territory described as follows:

WHEREAS, the annexation of the territory to the City has been initiated by landowners' statements of consent, in accordance with ORS 222.170, and would therefore constitute a so-called "triple majority" annexation under ORS 222.170 and a "minor boundary change" under the boundary commission law, ORS 199.410 to 199.510; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, at a special session held on the 5th day of November, 1975, that:

Section 1. The Council hereby approves the proposed annexation and requests the Commission to approve it and effect it as soon as possible.

Section 2. The City Recorder is hereby directed to file certified copies of the statements of consent and of this Resolution with the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission at once.

EXHIBIT "A"

PROPOSED ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF SHERWOOD

BEGINNING AT THE Southeast corner of Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Washington County, Oregon; thence S 89°12' W to the Southeast corner of the Thor L. Pederson property as described in deed book 494, page 252, said point being 666.20 feet East of the $\frac{1}{4}$ Section corner on the South line of said Section 30; thence N 38°07' W along the Easterly line of the said Pederson property and a Northwesterly prolongation in a straight line to the Northwest right of way line of S.W. Pacific State Highway; thence Southwest along said Northerly right of way to a point on the West line of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 30, said point being on the West line of the property of the State of Oregon as described in deed book 360, page 91; thence North to the centerline of S.W. Edy Road; thence East along said centerline to the Northwest corner of Elma Foster property as described in deed book 686, page 398; thence S 43°38' E 454.6 feet to the Northerly right of way of the said S.W. Pacific Highway; thence Southwest along said northerly right of way 1750 feet more or less to a point N 56°33' W of the most northerly corner of the Richard F. Smith property as described in deed book 422, page 001; thence S 56°33' E 2070 feet more or less to the place of beginning.
