

RESOLUTION 136

Sherwood City Council

WHEREAS, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statute 483.044, the City of Sherwood has authority to erect and maintain signs, markings and traffic control signals as are deemed necessary to direct and regulate traffic and to carry out the provisions of the Oregon State Motor Vehicle Code as adopted by the City of Sherwood, and

WHEREAS, the following action has been recommended by the Chief of Police and it appears to the City Council that it is appropriate and necessary to the public health and safety,

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved and ordered that the following traffic control signs be placed at the following locations in the City of Sherwood:

- 1) Such stops as are necessary at the intersection of Willamette St. with Lincoln St. so as to create a four-way stop at said intersection.
- 2) At the intersection of Norton St. and Willamette St. for traffic northbound on Norton St.
- 3) At the intersection of Hall St. and Willamette St. on the north east corner of Willamette St. for traffic west bound on Willamette St.
- 4) At the intersection of First St. and Main St. for traffic on First St.
- 5) At the intersection of Pine St. and Willamette St. for traffic southbound on Pine St.

Adopted by unanimous vote of the City Council of the City of Sherwood this 12 day of November, 1975.
