

RESOLUTION

Whereas the Common Council for the City of Sherwood has entered into certain agreements with the Unified Sewerage Agency for the operation of the City sewer system and under this agreement the City is required to provide a program of upgrading the collection system to prevent inflow and infiltration in accordance with the Unified Sewerage Agency's Waste Discharge Permit from the Dept. of Environmental Quality, and

Whereas the Common Council finds that it is in the best interest of the residents of the area and the City served by the Unified Sewerage Agency, therefore;

Be it Resolved that the following program and time schedule be adopted by the City of Sherwood


FY 76-77

1. Locate and repair as required all existing manholes
2. Construct additional manholes on old existing lines as required for access.
3. Smoke and dye test old lines for inflow and infiltration.
4. Correct problem areas found as funds will allow.


FY 77-78

1. Replace old lines with new ones on Washington St., Willamette and Pine Streets.
2. Additional Correction on existing lines.
3. Install new collectors to connect to main Sherwood trunk and eliminate old lines extending to present treatment plant.
