RESOLUTION
OF CITY COUNCIL OF
CITY OF SHERWOOD

WHEREAS Roy Street has been extended and connected with Willamette Street, and now intersects collector streets, and

WHEREAS the Council has considered the recommendations of the police chief, city administrator and residents served by said street and determined the signing and traffic regulations appropriate for said street,


Now, Therefore, it is hereby resolved that:

1. The designated speed to be posted on Roy Street, to be effective between the intersection of Roy Street and Oregon Street and the intersection of Roy Street and Willamette Street, shall be 15 miles per hour.

2. Roy Street shall be a stop street at its intersection with G.&T. Drive and stop signs shall be erected for north and south bound traffic on Roy Street at said intersection.


3. The city administrator shall be and hereby is directed to cause standard traffic signs to be installed as necessary to carry out the foregoing provisions.
