

CITY RESOLUTION FOR ANNEXATION
AND CONCURRENCE FOR TRIPLE MAJORITY

RESOLUTION NO. 152

A Resolution furthering annexation to the City of Sherwood of the territory described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the center line of Division Street and the East Boundary line of Sherwood City Limits, said point being 660 feet east of the center of Section 32, Township 2 South, Range 1, West, of the Willamette Meridian; thence east along the center line of Division Street 231.8 feet to the northwest corner of that tract of land conveyed to Robert G. and Joan M. Tasker March 11, 1971, such point being the point of beginning; thence South 225.63 feet; thence West 23.04 feet; thence South 104.4 feet; thence East 130.0 feet; thence North 310.0 feet to the South line of Division Street; thence North 20.0 feet to center of Division Street; thence West 107.0 feet on Division Street; to the point of beginning

WHEREAS, the annexation of the territory to the City has been initiated by landowners' statements of consent, in accordance with ORS 222.170, and would therefore constitute a so-called "triple majority" annexation under ORS 222.170 and a "minor boundary change" under the boundary commission law, ORS 199.410 to 199.510; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, at a regular session held on the 10th day of November, 1976, that:

Section 1. The Council hereby approved the proposed annexation and requests the Commission to approve it and effect it as soon as possible.

Section 2. The City Recorder is hereby directed to file certified copies of the statements of consent and of this Resolution with the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission at once.

The foregoing Resolution adopted this 10th day of November, 1976.
