RESOLUTION CANVASSING RETURNS OF REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION; PROCLAIMING RESULTS AND DIRECTING RECORDER TO ENTER ELECTION RESULT IN THE RECORD

WHEREAS, there has been duly and regularly certified to the City by the election board, the following returns of the election held in the City of Sherwood on November 2, 1976, wherat there was submitted to the electors the question of the election of a mayor, four councilmen, a charter amendment, and a new City tax base in the amount of \$38,000.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 14 of the Charter of the City of Sherwood, the Council is required to canvass the said returns and proclaim the results and direct the Recorder to enter the results in the records of the Council proceedings;
