

CITY RESOLUTION FOR ANNEXATION
AND CONCURRENCE FOR TRIPLE MAJORITY

RESOLUTION No. 155

A Resolution furthering annexation to the City of Sherwood of the territory described as follows:

Starting at a point 238.3 feet West from the N.E. corner of Sec. 32, T2S R1W, WM. said point being the intersection of the North line of Sec 32 with the center line of Murdock Road; thence West along said North Section line 523.5 feet more or less to the East line of Hackers Addition: thence South 1080 feet, more or less to the S.E. corner of Sherwood Acres: thence North 51 degrees and 23 minutes East 875 feet more or less to the center of Murdock Road: thence Northerly along said center line of Murdock Road to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, the annexation of the territory to the City has been initiated by landowners' statements of consent, in accordance with ORS 222.170, and would therefore constitute a so-called "triple majority" annexation under ORS 222.170 and a "minor boundary change" under the boundary commission law, ORS 199.410 to 199.510; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, at a Special session held on the 19th day of January, 1977, that:

Section 1. The Council hereby approved the proposed annexation and requests the Commission to approve it and effect it as soon as possible.

Section 2. The City Recorder is hereby directed to file certified copies of the statements of consent and of this Resolution with the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission at once.

The foregoing Resolution adopted this 19th day of January, 1977.
