

RESOLUTION 161

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING RENTAL RATES TO BE CHARGED BY THE EQUIPMENT RENTAL DEPT. OF THE CITY OF SHERWOOD

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Sherwood created an Equipment Rental Department by Ordinance No. 77-681, and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance provided that the Council should adopt a Resolution establishing rates to be charged for the rental of equipment administered by said department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Council of the City of Sherwood as follows:

SECTION 1

That the following listed rates shall be the charge for the rental of equipment administered by the Equipment Rental Department. Operator salary shall be charged at the existing rate. No equipment will be rented without a City operator.

The Director of Public Works is further authorized and directed to establish fees for servicing vehicles which fees shall be sufficient to reimburse the Equipment Rental Department for its actual cost of servicing.
