RESOLUTION NO. 189

WHEREAS the Cities of Sherwood, Tigard, and Tualatin desire to apply for funds from the Community Development Block Grant allotted by H. U. D. to Washington County for the acquisition and construction of public owned facilities for community centers to be available to senior citizens, low income persons, handicapped, and minorities from Tigard, Tualatin, King City, Durham, and Sherwood.

WHEREAS The City of Sherwood acting through and by the City Council approves and supports the three year plan for provision of such facilities to be submitted by the Cities of Sherwood, Tigard, and Tualatin, and

WHEREAS it is intended that the facilities be leased to Loaves and Fishes or a comparable organization, for operation and maintenance, and for provision of services to low income persons, senior citizens, handicapped persons, and to provide a facility available for programs of related community interest.

NOW THEREFORE It is Hereby Resolved, that the City of Sherwood requests funding for a community facility or center under the Community Development Block Grant program by H. U. D. as outlined in the three year development plan to be submitted by the Cities of Sherwood, Tigard and Tualatin, which plan shall be substantially as set forth in Exhibit A hereto attached.
